Lawrence "Larry" Thomas Hester

Larry was born on October 10, 1945 in Boston, Massachusetts to Benjamin and Angela Hester, who preceded him in death. He was educated in the Boston school systems. Larry attended Hampton University where he studied Engineering and was part of the Reserve Officers' Training Corps (ROTC) program. He confessed faith in our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ and was baptized at an early age.

From 1966 to 1970, Larry enlisted in the United States Air Force as an Administrative Specialist. During his four-year tenure, he lived abroad in Germany and Spain where he became fluent in the Spanish language, finishing his military service obligation stateside in South Dakota. After his active-duty enlistment, Larry continued to serve in the Reserves for an additional two years. Subsequently, he worked many years as a production manager for Pitney Bowes and various other companies. He also worked with various charities. He had a wealth of knowledge to offer in the business arena, in whatever office and capacity he served. Larry was known by many as a deep thinker, prolific writer and a brilliant intellectual.
